## **Background**

### **Residential Boilers**

Residential boilers are defined to be <300,000 Btu/h. The CEE specification for residential boilers is as follows:

Tier 1: 85% AFUE

Tier 2: 90% AFUE

This summary aims to capture all incentives for residential boilers, not only those that align with the CEE specification. Additionally, this summary captures any other measure related to boiler systems available to residential customers.

### **Residential Furnaces**

Residential furnaces are defined to be <225,000 Btu/h. The CEE specification for residential furnaces is as follows:

Tier 1: 90% AFUE

Tier 2: 92% AFUE

Tier 3: 94% AFUE

This summary aims to capture all incentives for residential furnaces, not only those that align with the CEE specification. Additionally, this summary captures other measures related to furnaces, including, but not limited to, efficient motors.

### **Climate Controls**

### **Direct Heating Equipment**

This equipment is also defined as "vented heating equipment". This equipment is used to heat the space without ducts. There are five product types as defined by DOE: gas wall - fan type, gas wall - gravity type, gas floor, gas room, and gas hearth (or fireplaces).
