- Refrigerator
- Dishwasher

### Commercial

- Clothes washer (family-sized)

## Residential and Commercial, Family-Sized Clothes Washer Specs

Efficiency Level	Modified Energy Factor (MEF)	Water Factor (WF)
Federal Standard (res. only)	1.26	-
ENERGY STAR	1.72	8.0
CEE Tier 1	1.80	7.5
CEE Tier 2	2.00	6.0
CEE Tier 3	2.20	4.5

## Residential Refrigerator Spec

- Expanded scope to include compact models
- CEE Tier levels remain unchanged

Efficiency Level	Percent Above Federal Standard	
	Mid- and Full-Size Refrigerators	Compact Refrigerators
ENERGY STAR	15	20
CEE Tier 1	20	
CEE Tier 2	25	
CEE Tier 3	30

<b>Compact Dishwashers</b>		
Federal Standard	0.46	-
ENERGY STAR	0.88	-
CEE Tier 1		252
