

Summary of Current Committee Activities

Last Updated: January 4, 2012

The CEE Commercial Kitchens Committee (the Committee) has two main focuses: technology assessment and market strategy. Technology assessment involves analyzing the potential benefit to efficiency programs of developing efficiency definitions for new commercial kitchen equipment categories, as well as revising current efficiency specifications as necessary. Market strategy involves discussion of strategies for program design and delivery that effectively engage the commercial foodservice market and meet member savings goals.

The CEE Commercial Kitchens Committee last met on December 20, 2011. The Committee will meet on an ad hoc basis in 2012. Committee members are encouraged to send call topic suggestions to the CEE Staff Contact below.

Technology Assessment

The Committee is actively working on:

1. Commercial kitchen demand control ventilation systems (CKV DCV): The Committee is proposing development of a clearinghouse of CKV DCV field studies conducted according to a common CEE field test guideline.
2. Providing input into the ENERGY STAR specification and revision processes. ENERGY STAR is currently examining [new specifications](#) for pre-rinse spray valves and [revisions](#) to the ice machine, dishwasher, and ovens specifications.

Market Strategy

The Committee has available [program guidance](#) documenting program design and delivery strategies used by Committee members to reach the range of market actors owning or operating commercial kitchens.
